#### Maung\_Myanmar/US\_ILDC1993

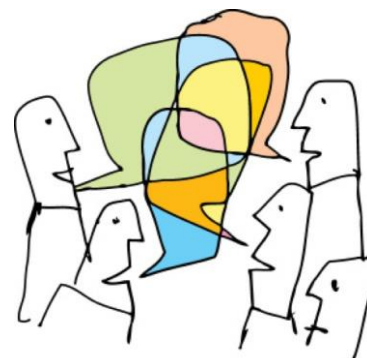
- Sharing by learning and learning by sharing
